4. Current City Council Member (four terms) and two-term former Mayor, Franklin, Ohio.

In this testimony, I am representing only myself and Sleep Tite Mattress Factory & Showroom and HomeCare Mobility, both Divisions of HomeCare Mattress, Inc.

5. a) Sleep Tite Mattress Factory & Showroom does not participate in any Federal Grants or Contracts. HomeCare Mobility does participate in the Federal Government Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) Program. The FSS Program is not a contract. HomeCare Mobility was issued an FSS (FSS #V797D-30204), in 2013. When ordering medical equipment (over \$3,000), the VA is required to obtain three (3) competitive bids. The rigorous FSS process "certifies" that a vendor has met the necessary Federal Guidelines required to submit bids and perform work for the Federal Government.

5.b) Per 5.a (above), the FSS is not a contract. Through the Certified Bid Process:

-HomeCare Mobility: 2013: VA Medical System, \$213,390.28 (9.3% of total)

-HomeCare Mobility: 2014: VA Medical System, \$528,108.34 (17.9% of total)
