The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled “Oversight of the Small Business Innovation Research and Small Business Technology Transfer Programs—Part II.” The hearing is scheduled to begin at **1:00 P.M. on July 23, 2014 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

This will be the second of two oversight hearings examining the programmatic changes to both the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) Programs following enactment of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2012 (P.L. 112-81). This hearing will focus on the public sector actions of the Small Business Administration, National Institutes of Health, and the Department of Defense following the numerous changes contained in the reauthorization, which was signed into law as part of the FY 2012 NDAA.
