The House Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing entitled, *Adding to Uncertainty: The Impact of DOL/NLRB Decisions and Proposed Rules on Small Businesses*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **1:00 P.M. on October 5, 2011, in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The hearing will focus on recent decisions and proposed rules by the National Labor Relations Board and the Department of Labor that some fear disadvantage small businesses in union organizing drives.
