The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, "Export Control Reform: Challenges for Small Business? (Part II)." The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, February 11, 2016 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The Committee will examine the ongoing Export Control Reform Initiative (ECR Initiative) and the implications for America's small business exporters. Small businesses account for 98 percent of United States exporters. However, these small businesses face significant challenges when navigating the complex export control system. As a follow up to the Small Business Subcommittee on Agriculture Energy and Trade hearing "Export Control Reform: Challenges for Small Business? (Part I)" the Small Business Committee will hear directly from Administration officials on their continuing effort to complete export control reform and what steps are being taken to address the challenges and reduce the burdens small businesses engaged in exporting continue to face.
