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The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Contracting and the Workforce will meet for a hearing titled, "Hotline Truths: Issues Raised by Recent Audits of Defense Contracting." The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, February 25, 2016 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

As part of the Subcommittee's ongoing efforts to identify waste, fraud and abuse in federal contracting and to ensure that small contractors have the opportunity to compete, the Subcommittee will hear from the Department of Defense Inspector General (DODIG) concerning the results of two recent audits it conducted. As a result of hotline complaints, the DODIG has begun reviewing contracting activities for compliance with the Small Business Act. The hearing will allow the Subcommittee to receive testimony on the findings of the first two audits, and put those findings in context. Specifically, the audits address compliance with the prime contracting and subcontracting requirements of the Small Business Act.
