The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled *Buried in Paperwork: A 1099 Update*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **1:00 p.m. on February 9, 2011 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The Committee will examine the expanded 1099 information reporting requirements in Section 9006 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. Lungren (R-CA), the sponsor of H.R. 4, *Small Business Paperwork Mandate Elimination Act of 2011*, which would repeal Section 9006 of the Act.
