The Subcommittee on Contracting and Workforce will meet for a hearing titled, “*Obamacare and the Self-Employed: What About Us?*” The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M., Thursday, March 6, 2014 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The purpose of the hearing is to examine the effect of the President’s health care law on the self-employed. Like businesses with employees, the self-employed also need to purchase health insurance.
