The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Investigations, Oversight and Regulations will meet for a hearing titled, "*JOBS Act Implementation Update*." The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, April 11, 2013 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

Almost one year ago, the Jumpstart Our Business Startups Act was enacted. This bipartisan legislation was designed to increase access to capital for small businesses by reducing regulatory burdens on businesses seeking access to financing via the public markets and the Internet. To implement this law, the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) is required to draft several rules. However, despite deadlines set out in the law, the SEC has still not promulgated regulations. This hearing will review the SEC's efforts to implement this law and examine how delays have affected small business.
