The Subcommittee on Economic Growth, Tax and Capital Access will meet for a hearing titled, *Keep It Simple: Small Business Tax Simplification and Reform, Main Street Speaks*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, April 13, 2016 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building**.

The Subcommittee will meet with a private sector panel to examine key tax issues as they apply to small businesses. Corporations and partnerships with more than 50 employees face a tax compliance burden of approximately \$182 to \$191 per employee, but this number skyrockets to \$4,308 to \$4,736 per employee for the smallest employers with 1-5 employees. The hearing will focus on some of the most egregious areas of both substantive and administrative complexity from the small business perspective and provide a discussion of potential solutions.
