The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, *S Is for Savings: Pro-Growth Benefits of Employee-Owned S Corporations*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, April 27, 2016 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building**.

The Committee will meet to discuss employee-owned S corporations and H.R. 2096, the Promotion and Expansion of Private Employee Ownership Act of 2015, which has been referred to this Committee.

S corporations that sponsor employee stock ownership plans (S ESOPs) are vital economic players in the United States. The hearing will examine how S ESOPs establish employee ownership, and the benefits that may accrue to the small business and the economy as a result. This hearing will examine possible measures to encourage S ESOP proliferation, including H.R. 2096, the Promotion and Expansion of Private Employee Ownership Act of 2015.
