The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Contracting and Workforce will meet for a hearing titled, *Putting the Strategy in Sourcing: Challenges and Opportunities for Small Business Contractors*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 13, 2013 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The purpose of the hearing is to receive testimony on the effects of the Federal Strategic Sourcing Initiative (FSSI) on small businesses. Specifically, the hearing will address the following areas: 1) the Administration's new strategic sourcing council and its efforts to make strategic sourcing mandatory; 2) the One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services (OASIS) and OASIS Small Business (OASIS SB) contracts; and 3) FSSI commodity initiatives currently under consideration by the General Services Administration (GSA) and their effects on the health of GSA's other contracts.
