The House Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, *Lifting the Weight of Regulations: Growing Jobs by Reducing Regulatory Burdens*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **1:00 P.M. on June 15, 2011 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building**.

This hearing will examine H.R. 527, the Regulatory Flexibility Improvements Act of 2011, and H.R. 585, the Small Business Size Standard Flexibility Act of 2011. The two bills are designed to remove loopholes in the Regulatory Flexibility Act (RFA), as amended by the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act (SBREFA), and strengthen the power of the Office of the Chief Counsel for Advocacy.
