The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Health and Technology will meet for a hearing titled, *Mobile Medical App Entrepreneurs: Changing the Face of Health Care*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on June 27, 2013 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

An estimated 500 million smartphones worldwide will be using a medical application (“app”) by 2015, and one study showed that 78% of top app developers are small businesses. Entrepreneurs are creating groundbreaking mobile apps to help empower consumers to make better health care decisions, allow patients to access critical health data at any time and anywhere and guide physicians to diagnose or monitor patient conditions. These apps, providing an estimated 500,000 jobs and nearly \$25 billion in revenue, are also helping to grow the economy. The focus of the hearing will be how entrepreneurs and their mobile medical apps are changing the face of health care.
