The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Contracting and the Workforce will meet for a hearing titled, "Sizing Up Small Business: SBA's Failure to Implement Congressional Direction." The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 4, 2015 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The hearing will examine the Small Business Administration's (SBA) implementation of section 1661 of the National Defense Authorization Act of 2013. This section revised the process by which the SBA creates size standards. The hearing will review the causes that led Congress to enact section 1661, and consider whether additional legislation is necessary to ensure that the aims of section 1661 are met.
