The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Agriculture, Energy and Trade will meet for a hearing titled, *The President's Climate Action Plan: What Is the Impact on Small Businesses?* The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 a.m. on July 18, 2013 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

On June 25, 2013, President Obama announced "The President's Climate Action Plan" which seeks, in part, to use rulemaking by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to reduce domestic greenhouse gas emissions from power plants. The hearing will examine the potential small business implications of the GHG emissions limitations outlined in the President's Action Plan, as well as review the EPA's plans to comply with the requirements of the Regulatory Flexibility Act.
