The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Economic Growth, Tax and Capital Access will conduct a hearing titled, *Adding to Uncertainty: Small Businesses' Perspectives on the Tax Cliff*. The hearing is scheduled to begin at **10:00 A.M. on September 13, 2012 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

As many small businesses are organized as "pass-through" entities, where business owners pay their taxes at individual rates, the hearing will examine how the potential expiration of the 2001 and 2003 tax cuts is influencing small businesses' decision making. The hearing will also examine small businesses' perspectives on the Obama Administration's tax proposal to allow the top two marginal tax rates to increase for taxpayers with income in excess of \$200,000 a year (\$250,000 if filing jointly).
