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**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4783**  
**OFFERED BY MS. VELÁZQUEZ OF NEW YORK**

Page 5, after line 14, insert the following new paragraph and redesignate the paragraphs accordingly:

1           (9) is subsection (mm)(6), insert “, not later  
2           than June 30 of each year,” after “shall”.

Page 5, after line 22, insert the following:

3           (c) FAILURE TO REPORT ADMINISTRATIVE  
4 FUNDS.—Section 9(mm) of the Small Business Act (15  
5 U.S.C. 638(mm)) is amended by adding at the end the  
6 following new paragraph:

7           “(7) FAILURE TO REPORT ADMINISTRATIVE  
8 FUNDS.—

9           “(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than March  
10           30 following each fiscal year for which funds  
11           are authorized to be used by a Federal agency  
12           under paragraph (1), the Federal agency shall  
13           submit a report to the Administrator that iden-  
14           tifies how the Federal agency used such funds  
15           during such fiscal year.

16           “(B) FAILURE TO SUBMIT A REPORT.—If  
17           a Federal agency fails to submit a report re-

1           required under subparagraph (A), paragraph (1)  
2           shall not apply to such Federal agency unless—  
3                     “(i) such report is submitted; and  
4                     “(ii) such Federal agency submits an  
5           additional report to the Administrator that  
6           identifies how such Federal agency plans  
7           to ensure timely reporting under this para-  
8           graph.”.

At the end of the bill add the following:

9   **SEC. 8. INCREASED UNDERSERVED POPULATION PARTICI-**  
10                   **PATION WAIVER REMOVED.**

11           (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9(mm)(2) of the Small  
12 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 638(mm)(2)) is amended to read  
13 as follows:

14                   “(2) OUTREACH AND TECHNICAL ASSIST-  
15           ANCE.—A Federal agency participating in the pro-  
16           gram under this subsection shall use a portion of the  
17           funds authorized for uses under paragraph (1) to  
18           carry out the policy directive required under sub-  
19           section (j)(2)(F) and to increase the participation of  
20           States with respect to which a low level of SBIR  
21           awards have historically been awarded.”.

22           (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 9(mm)(6)  
23 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 638(mm)(6)) is

1 amended by striking “(A) and any use of the waiver au-  
2 thority under paragraph (2)(B)”.
