

**AMENDMENT TO THE COMMITTEE PRINT
OFFERED BY MR. SCHRADER OF OREGON**

Page 87, after line 6, insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 505. INSPECTOR GENERAL REPORTS.

2 Not later than October 1 of each year, the Inspector
3 General of each Federal agency that participates in the
4 SBIR program or STTR program shall submit to the
5 Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship of
6 the Senate and the Committee on Small Business and the
7 Committee on Science, Space, and Technology of the
8 House of Representatives a report describing—

9 (1) the number of cases referred to the Inspec-
10 tor General in the preceding year that related to
11 fraud, waste, or abuse with respect to the SBIR pro-
12 gram or STTR program;

13 (2) the actions taken in each case described in
14 paragraph (1) if fraud, waste, or abuse was deter-
15 mined to have occurred;

16 (3) if no action was taken in a case described
17 in paragraph (1) and fraud, waste, or abuse was de-
18 termined to have occurred, the justification for ac-
19 tion not being taken; and

1 (4) an accounting of the funds used to address
2 fraud, waste, and abuse, including a description of
3 personnel and resources funded and funds that were
4 recovered or saved.
