Dear Administrator Guzman:

The House Committee on Small Business (Committee) writes regarding additional concerns related to the travel of senior Small Business Administration (SBA) officials. During the 118th Congress, the Committee has been investigating claims that the SBA has been using taxpayer resources on partisan or otherwise inappropriate travel. Through the course of the Committee's investigation, the Committee received outreach alleging that the Region IV Administrator, Allen Thomas, is engaged in improper and wasteful travel.

As the Committee has previously stated, SBA employees traveling and engaging with small business owners is a valuable part of the SBA's mission. Conversely, using taxpayer resources for personal or political travel is unacceptable. Given the Committee's ongoing investigation, and reports that Regional Administrator Thomas may have wasted substantial taxpayer resources when he was the Executive Director of Global TransPark, the Committee seeks to ensure that taxpayer resources are not being redirected to fund improper travel.¹ To that end, the Committee requests the following information and answers as soon as possible but no later than December 13, 2024:

- 1. The travel records of Regional Administrator Thomas from January 1, 2022, through December 2024.
- 2. The travel itineraries for trips Regional Administrator Thomas has taken, and is currently scheduled to take in the future, including where, when, and with whom, from January 1, 2022, through the end of the year.
- 3. All trip summaries and/or related documents memorializing reimbursement for costs associated with political activities under the Hatch Act for Regional Administrator Thomas, including all reimbursement statements, for all trips encompassed in request 1 and 2 of this letter.
