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The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, "Evaluating the Paperwork Reduction Act: Are Burdens Being Reduced?" The hearing is scheduled to begin at **11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, March 29, 2017 in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The purpose of the hearing is to examine the Paperwork Reduction Act. With some limited exceptions, the Paperwork Reduction Act requires all executive departments and independent regulatory agencies to obtain approval from the Office of Management and Budget in advance of collecting information from or imposing a reporting or recordkeeping requirement on 10 or more persons. The Committee will examine the Paperwork Reduction Act's effectiveness in reducing the paperwork burden on small businesses and issues that may warrant further scrutiny or legislative action.
