The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, “Damaging Repercussions: DOL’s Overtime Rule, Small Employers, and their Employees.” **The hearing is scheduled to begin at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, June 23, 2016, in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

Last month, the Wage and Hour Division of the Department of Labor issued a final regulation that revises the existing Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) regulations that implement the exemption from minimum wage and overtime pay for executive, administrative, professional, outside sales and computer employees. Most private and public sector employers are covered by the FLSA and must be in compliance with the final rule by December 1, 2016. The Committee will examine on the effects of the overtime rule on small employers and their employees.
