The Committee on Small Business Subcommittee on Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Workforce Development will hold a remote hearing titled: “Growing Jobs through Infrastructure Investment.” The hearing is scheduled to begin at **1:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 6, 2021** via the **Zoom platform** (information to be provided).
