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The Committee on Small Business will meet for a hearing titled, “*SBA Management Review: Oversight of SBA’s Access to Capital Offices.*” **The hearing is scheduled to begin at 10 A.M. on January 12, 2016, in Room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building.**

The United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) recently released a report about the operation of the Small Business Administration (SBA) and found numerous deficiencies in SBA management. In conjunction with this report, the Committee is holding a series of hearings that will provide oversight of various SBA offices and examine ways to improve current challenges. This hearing will examine the Office of Capital Access and Office of Credit Risk Management. Specifically, the hearing will look at whether improvements within these Offices are necessary to ensure sufficient lender oversight and effectiveness in helping small firms obtain capital.
