

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4668
OFFERED BY MR. COMER OF KENTUCKY

Page 10, strike lines 9 through 14 and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 4. PROHIBITION ON NEW APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—No additional funds are author-
3 ized to be appropriated to carry out this Act and the
4 amendments made by this Act.

5 (b) **EXISTING FUNDING.**—This Act and the amend-
6 ments made by this Act shall be carried out using amounts
7 made available under section 21(a)(4)(C)(viii) of the Small
8 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 648(a)(4)(viii)).

9 (c) **TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—
10 Section 21(a)(4)(C)(viii) of the Small Business Act (15
11 U.S.C.648(a)(4)(C)(viii)) is amended to read as follows:

12 “(viii) **LIMITATION.**—

13 “(I) **CYBERSECURITY ASSIST-**
14 **ANCE.**—From the funds appropriated
15 pursuant to clause (vii), the Adminis-
16 tration shall reserve not less than
17 \$1,000,000 in each fiscal year to de-
18 velop cybersecurity assistance units at

1 small business development centers
2 under paragraph (9).

3 “(II) PORTABLE ASSISTANCE.—

4 “(aa) IN GENERAL.—Any
5 funds appropriated pursuant to
6 clause (vii) that are remaining
7 after reserving amounts under
8 subclause (I) may be used for
9 portable assistance for startup
10 and sustainability non-matching
11 grant programs to be conducted
12 by eligible small business develop-
13 ment centers in communities that
14 are economically challenged as a
15 result of a business or govern-
16 ment facility down sizing or clos-
17 ing, which has resulted in the
18 loss of jobs or small business in-
19 stability.

20 “(bb) GRANT AMOUNT AND
21 USE.—A non-matching grant
22 under this subclause shall not ex-
23 ceed \$100,000, and shall be used
24 for small business development
25 center personnel expenses and re-
